

Who May Attend:

Boys and Girls - Baseball & Softball Players, Ages 10 - High School Senior Participants will be split up according to sport and age.

Camp is open to any and all entrants, limited only by number, age and grade level

Cost:

\$175 per player (if pre-registered online by June 27).

On-site after June 27, \$190

If paying on-site cash, money orders/cashiers checks or credit cards are accepted forms of payment (no personal checks please). 4% added to credit card transactions.

Pre-registered sibling discount: \$160 per player (no on-site registration discounts).


