Text Camp Director Barry Dean at (334)676-0434 to see if spots are available after June 30. No walk-ups for camp attendance.

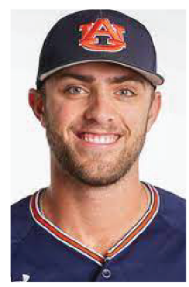
Camp attendees will bring their own lunch to camp. Number of attendees need to be known ahead of time in order to adequately staff the camp with coaches.
